Sytchampton School Lottery Club

Welcome to our new fund-raising activity, a great way for you to support the school whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works

All families of pupils are invited to buy a minimum of 4 numbers between 1 and 250 and at the end of each ½ a term a draw takes place and the people with the winning number wins the prize.

Each number costs £2 and the prize money is always 15% of the total numbers sold so when all 250 numbers are sold then the 1st prize is £100 and the 2nd prize is £50.

As a starting point the funds raised will aim to cover transport costs for school trips – resulting in a significant reduction in requests for voluntary contributions. As parents we all value these trips and opportunities for our children.

The cost is only £2 per number per month and there will be 6 prize draws during the year. Draw dates are during a celebration assembly and the first one will take at the Valentines Disco on 12th February.

We hope that you will support this fund-raising Lottery Club and please feel free to buy more numbers to increase your chance of winning!

WELCOME TO THE SYTCHAMPTON SCHOOL LOTTERY CLUB!

Welcome to our Lottery Club – Sytchampton School's new fund-raising activity - a great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

Please complete and sign the attached membership form and Standing Order mandate for £2 per number per month – (we will allocate) - which enters you into the ½ termly draw. All participants must be over 16.

There will be two categories of members:-

Founder Members – parents of current pupils – minimum quantity of numbers to be purchased = 4 (£8 per month / £96 per year)

Friend & Family Members – Friends & Families of pupils, School, Staff and School Governors – minimum quantity of numbers to be purchased = 1 (£2 per month / £24 per year)

There will be 6 draws per calendar year - a draw will take place on the last Friday of each half a term – during the school assembly.

If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address (or handed to you on the day if you are at the draw) and the name of the winner published in the school's monthly newsletter and on Facebook and the school's website.

The annual prize fund will be 15% of the total membership fee. There will be 6 x ½ termly draws, if all numbers are sold the 1st prize will be £100 and the 2nd prize £50. The remaining 85% goes to PTA school funds to part contribute towards to cost of trips and travel for all pupils (currently funded by parental “voluntary contributions”)

Tickets can be purchased by anyone (**over the age of 16**) with connections to the school - so please ask grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, etc. to join in and buy a number.

SYTCHAMPTON SCHOOL LOTTERY CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Lottery Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet transport funding requests from the school, providing travel and trip opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per number you will be allocated one number between 1 and 250.
2. The minimum numbers to be purchased by parents/carers of current pupils is 4 (£8 per month, £96 per year).
3. Friends / extended families / school staff and School Governors are invited to buy 1 or more numbers @ £2 per month (£24 per year)
4. A draw will be made every ½ a term with a 1st and 2nd prize.
5. The annual prize fund will total 15% of the annual income.
6. Each ½ a term this will be apportioned as a 1st prize of £100 and 2nd prize of £50 assuming 250 numbers are sold.
7. The Lottery Club is a private society lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Sytchampton School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
8. Numbers are not limited
9. Payments must be made by standing order. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
10. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
11. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
12. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher in the last assembly each 1/2 of term.
13. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application on the day of the draw, or handed to you if you attend the assembly.
14. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website.
15. The Lottery Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Lottery Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
17. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
