- To receive and be informed about performance data as presented by the Headteacher and to monitor pupil progress
- To consider and advise the governing body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements and the School's Curriculum Policy
- To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance, Premises and Personnel Committee decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the governing body
- To make arrangements for the governing body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the LA and for reports to be received by the governing body
- To oversee arrangements for individual governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision, including safeguarding, SEN, literacy and numeracy
- To receive regular reports from the above and advise the governing body
- To oversee arrangements for educational visits
- To act as a critical friend for curriculum development
- To report back to the governing body
