# PARENTS AGREEMENT

Parents will endeavour to:

- Ensure that their child arrives at school on time, with the correct equipment and named school uniform.
- Inform school about any problems which might affect learning or behaviour.
- Give support with reading and other home learning and link this to family activities.
- Encourage commitment to extra-curricular activities.
- Attend parents consultations and other curriculum meetings.
- Support the school's policies, school rules and guidelines for behaviour and supervise your child on the playground before 8.45am.
- Ensure that the child attends school for all sessions with the exception of medical circumstances.
- Ensure that the school has up to date contact information and that your child's medical records are up to date eg. allergies, inhalers.
- Support the school's Healthy status and ECO schools with regard to healthy lunch boxes, snacks and promoting a waste-free environment.
- Act as a role model to their child by accessing online information safely.
- Act in a courteous manner and if have a problem or concern with school, parents agree not to discuss online or on social media, but to contact the school via the correct channels.

- **To follow instructions, listen carefully in order to become outstanding learners.**

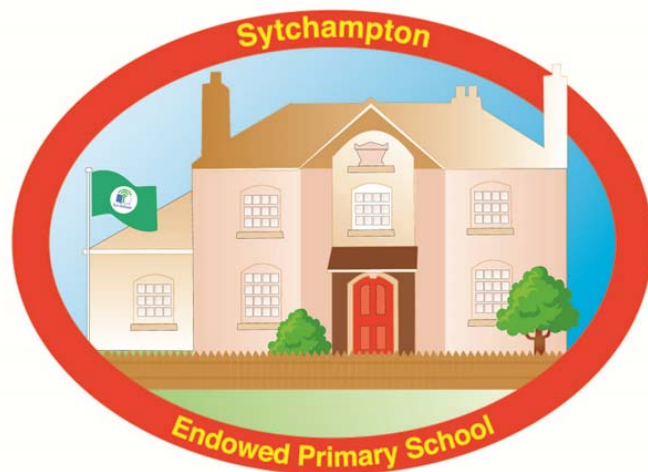
Pupils are also asked :
