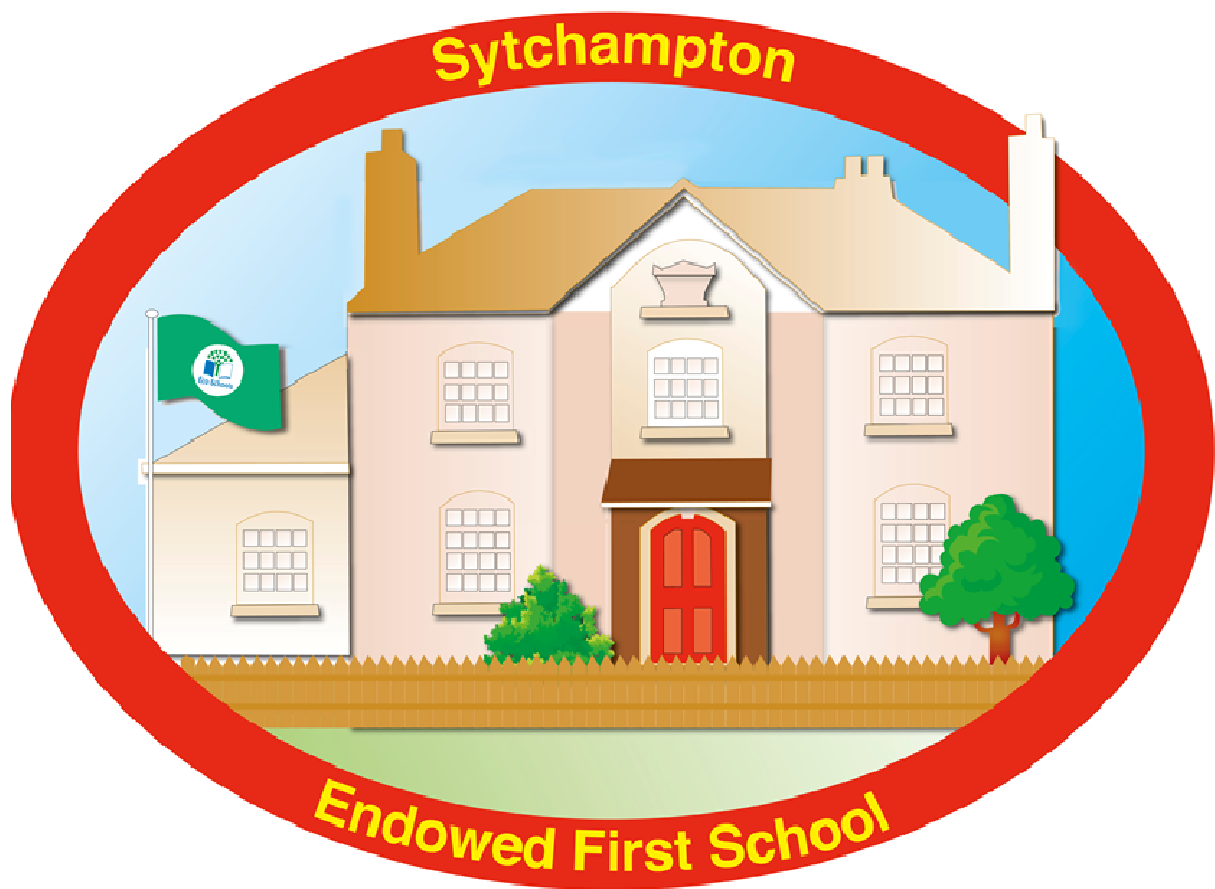


# HOLIDAY HOMEWORK FOR YEAR 1

## READING:

- Encourage children to develop a pleasure for reading and also understand that there are a wide range of books. The library in Droitwich has a summer reading scheme.
- Ask your child to predict events, discuss the layout of the book and illustrations.
- Read to them and discuss what has been read to check their understanding.
- At this age becoming familiar with fairy/traditional tales is important

## WRITING:

- Learn to spell the days of the week.
- A simple diary - just a sentence per day would be great (see attached).
- Name the letters of the alphabet (lots of songs about this).
- Write simple sentences using their phonics knowledge of letter sounds to spell.

## **MATHS**

- **Count, read and write numbers to 100**
- **Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10**
- **Give a number then find 1 more and 1 less.**
