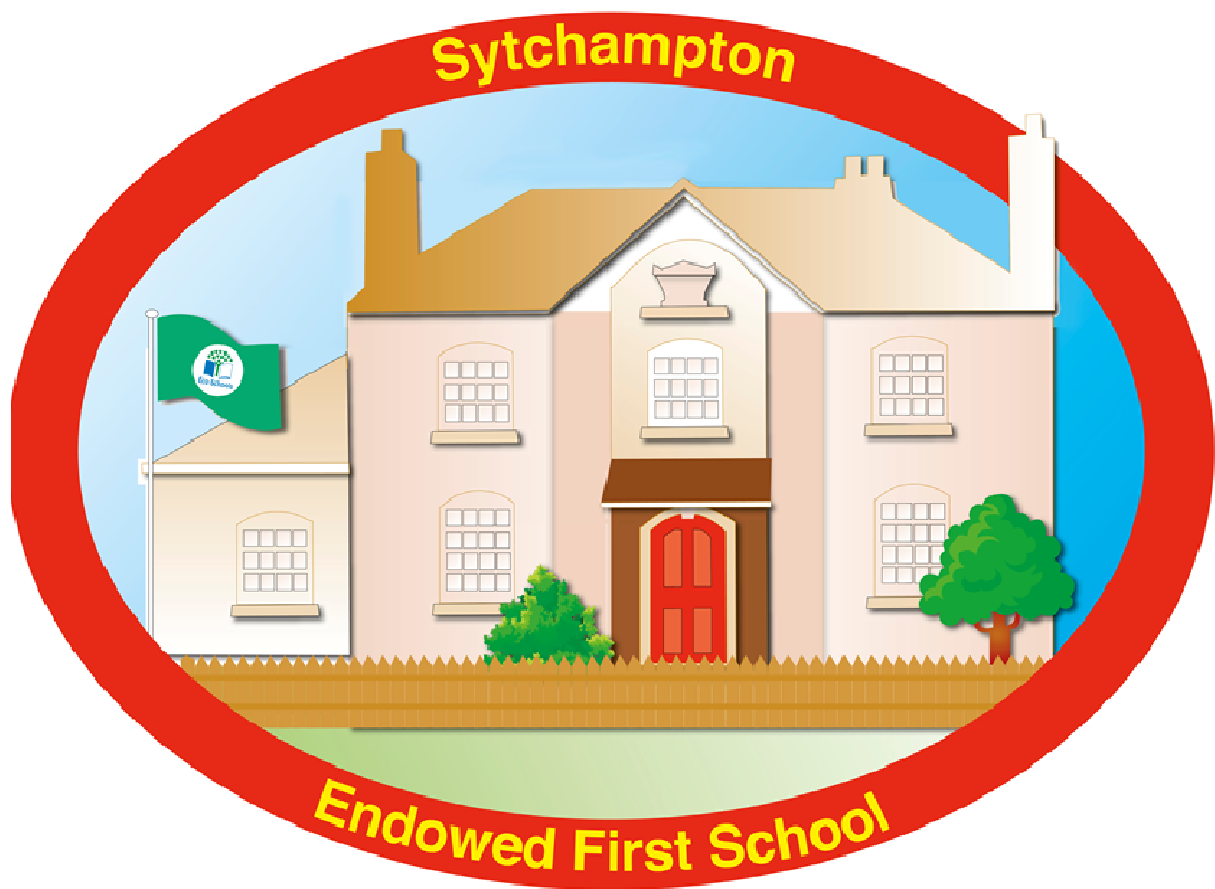


HOLIDAY HOMEWORK FOR YEAR 2

READING:

TRY and complete our READING BINGO CARD!

- Encourage children to develop a pleasure for reading and also understand that there are a wide range of books. The library in Droitwich has a summer reading scheme.
- Ask your child to predict events, discuss the layout of the book and illustrations.
- At this age children should be working on accuracy and speed of reading - learning to read well.

WRITING:

- Practice your handwriting - forming letters correctly and of the same size.
- A holiday diary - A couples of sentences. Try some longer sentences using because, and, but, if, when.

- Find some homophones: these are words that sound the same but are spelt differently EXAMPLES:

- Hear, here
- Their, there
- Son, sun
- One, won
- Knight, night
- See. Sea
- To, two and too

Can you put these words into sentences?

MATHS

- Count in multiples of 2,3 and 5.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numbers and words.
- Recognise 2 digit numbers and break down into tens and units.
