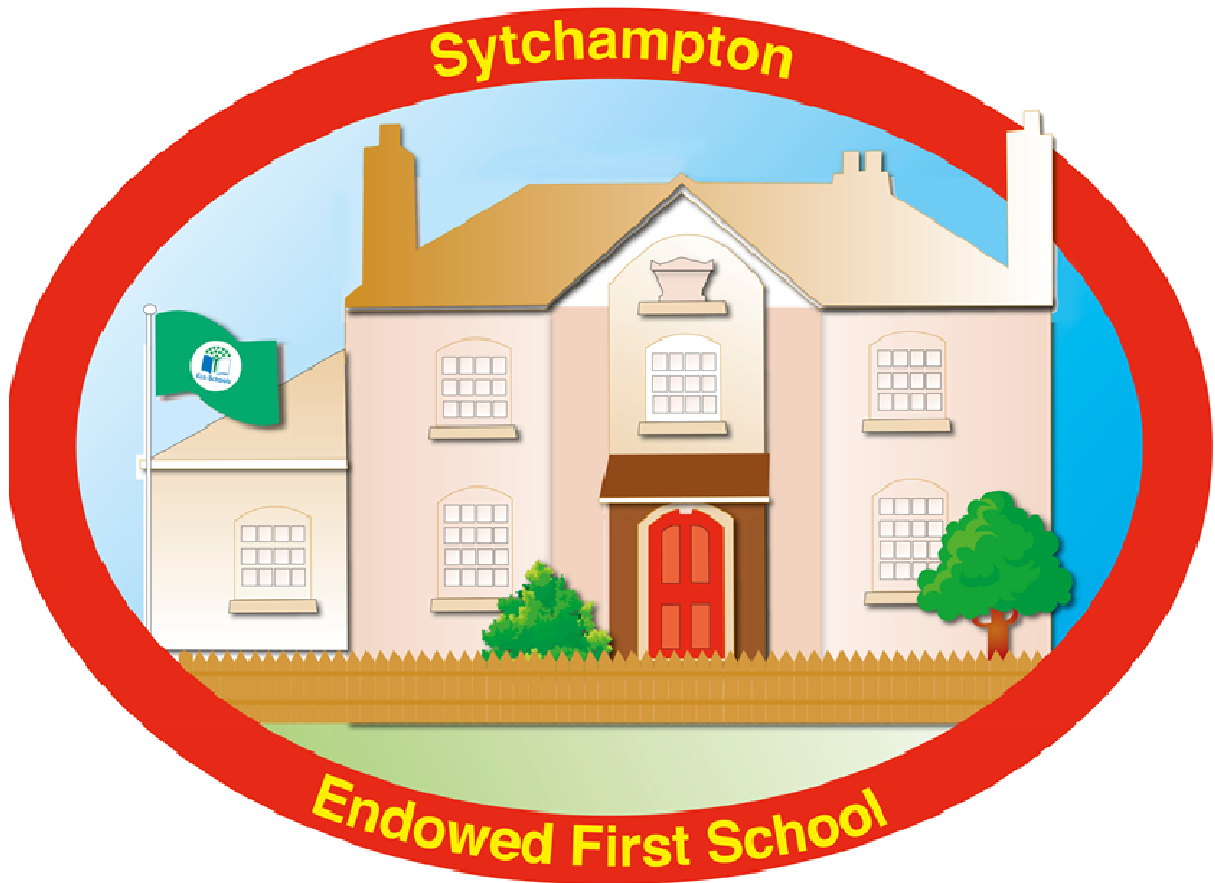


HOLIDAY HOMEWORK FOR

READING:

TRY OUR READING BINGO CARD!

- Encourage children to develop a pleasure for reading and also understand that there are a wide range of books. The library in Droitwich has a summer reading scheme.
- At this age children should be working on accuracy and speed of reading - learning to read confidently.
- Ask your child to retell a story to you using expression and voice.

WRITING:

- Practice your handwriting - forming letters correctly, joining letters and improving quality of hand writing.
- A holiday diary - A couples of sentences. Try some longer sentences using because,

although, however and add in some extra information using commas.

- Find some homophones: these are words that sound the same but are spelt differently EXAMPLES:

- Break/brake
- Grate/great
- Medal/meddle
- Peace/piece
- Rain/rein/reign
- Weather/whether

MATHS

- Learn your times tables and look for links, example between 3 and 6 x table.
- Build up your mental maths ability to add and subtract numbers in your head.

- Learn your number bonds with 3 digit number, eg. what do you add to 273 to make 300?
