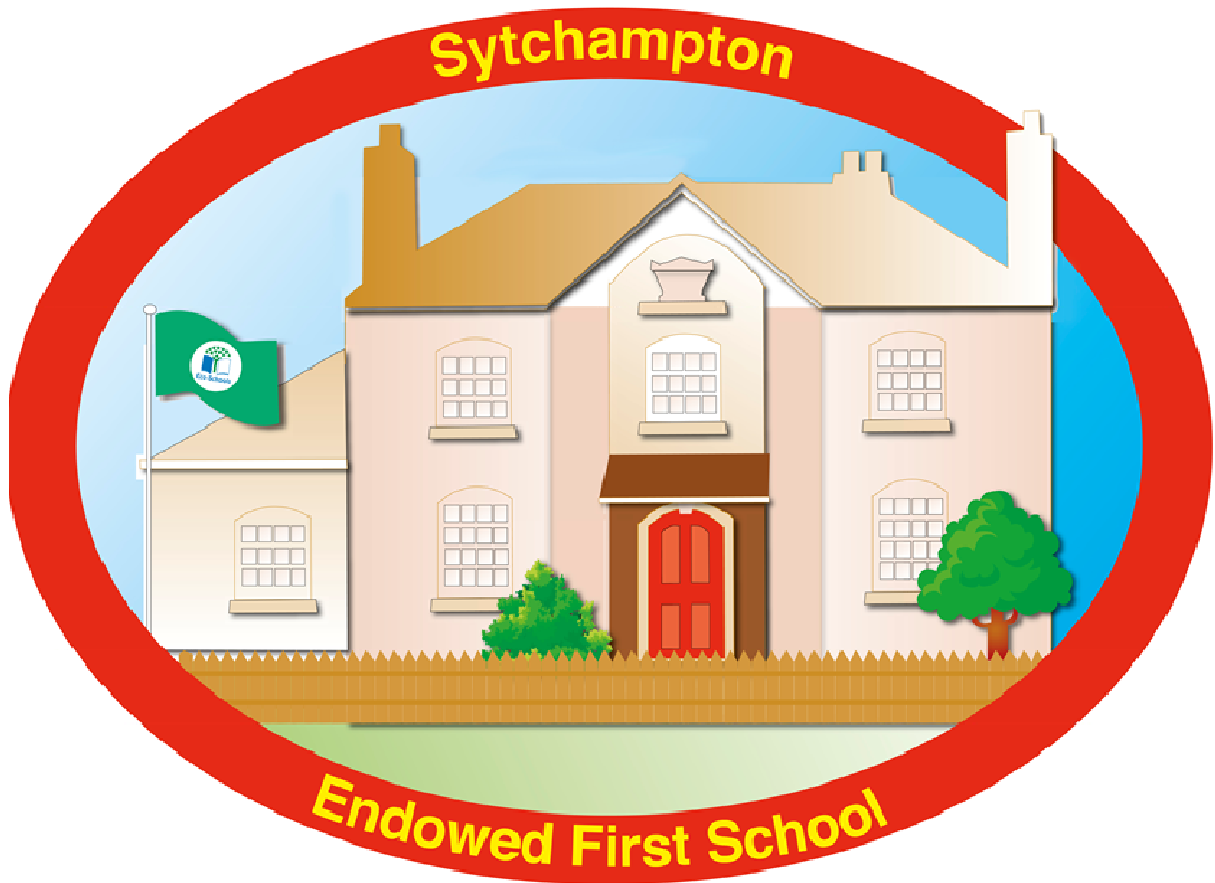


HOLIDAY HOMEWORK FOR YEAR 5
